Significant Hazards	People at risk from identified hazards	Existing controls / where information may be found Further actions necessary to control the risk
<b>Injury from organised activity e.g. burnt by BBQ / hit by ball</b>	All members & guests and visitors	Participants joining in organised games should be fit enough and be wearing suitable clothing. If possible a first aider should be present with access to first aid kit. Children should be with parent / guardian and should be kept away from BBQ or fires. A small group to take charge of cooking. Organise small manageable groups to participate in the event.
<b>Significant injury e.g. dislocations, cuts</b>	All members & guests & visitors	Trip /event organisers to familiarise themselves with the location of nearest Accident & Emergency departments
<b>Confrontation with members of the public</b>	All members, guests & visitors	Regents members should behave in a polite, non-confrontational way toward members of the public and attempt to resolve any dispute in a civilised manner.
<b>Too much booze</b>	All members, guests & visitors	Participants in organised activities should take responsibility for themselves and maintain a reasonable level of sobriety.
<b>Trips generally - travel, boat transport, gear</b>	All members	Members to seek advice and information on best practice re transport, tying boats securely to cars, suitable equipment and its use, and suitability of a particular trip for them vis-a-vis their ability.
